Ensemble para suspensión de trasero**INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

- Raise vehicle allowing the axle to hang freely.
- Remove existing bump stop by prying out of bump stop cup.
- Position Timbren spring assembly into bump stop cup as shown in Diagram A.
- Use soapy water and position Aeon spring assembly into bump stop cup. Push and twist simultaneously.
- Ensure Timbren assembly is properly seated in bump stop cup.
- To ensure that the Aeon assembly is properly seated in the cup, it will help to place a temporary spacer such as a short piece of 2x4 wood between the axle and the Aeon assembly.
- Lower vehicle.

*Do not exceed vehicle manufacturer's recommended axle weight rating. Check for AEON® interference with vehicle components - Under load AEON® will "expand" in diameter.*

**INSTRUCTIONS DE MONTAGE**

- Soulever le véhicule de sorte que l'essieu soit dégagé.
- Retirer la butée de suspension existante en insérant un levier dans l'échancrure de la butée de suspension.
- Placer le bloc de ressorts Timbren dans l'échancrure de la butée de suspension comme il est indiqué dans le schéma A.
- Utiliser de l'eau savonneuse et placer le bloc de ressorts Aeon dans l'échancrure de la butée de suspension. Pousser et tourner simultanément.
- S'assurer que l'assemblage Timbren soit convenablement placé dans l'échancrure de la butée de suspension.
- Pour s'assurer que l'assemblage Aeon est placé correctement dans l'échancrure, il sera préférable d'installer une entretoise temporaire, comme une petite planche de bois (2x4), entre l'essieu et l'assemblage Aeon avant de baisser le véhicule. Soulever le véhicule une fois de plus pour retirer l'entretoise temporaire.
- Redescendre le véhicule.

*Ne pas dépasser le poids nominal sur l'essieu recommandé par le fabricant du véhicule. Vérifier que le ressort AEON® n'a pas d'incidence sur d'autres pièces du véhicule - Le ressort AEON® augmentera son diamètre avec la charge.*

**INSTRUCCIONES DE INSTALACIÓN**

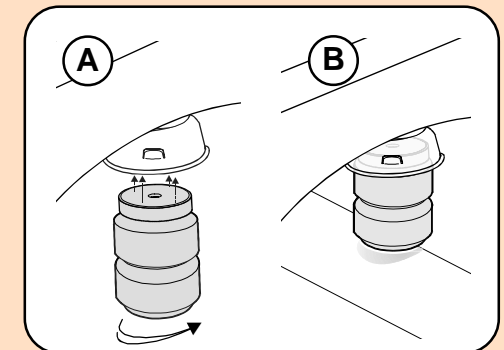
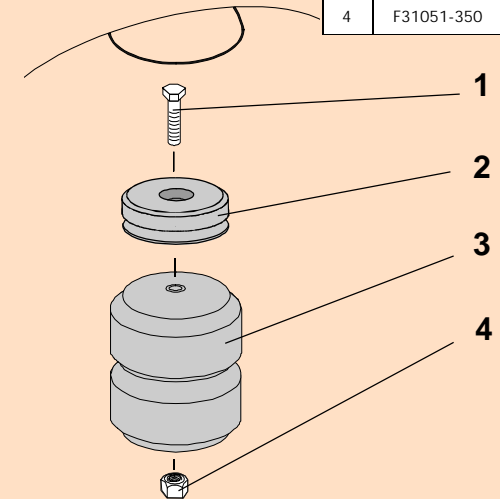
- Levante el vehículo dejando que los ejes cuelguen libremente.
- Retire el tope de suspensión existente haciendo palanca en la copa del tope de retención
- Coloque en posición la unidad de resorte Timbren en la copa del tope de retención como se muestra en el Diagrama A.
- Utilizar agua con jabón y coloque en posición la unidad de resorte Aeon en la copa del tope de retención. Empuje y tuerza simultáneamente.
- Asegúrese de que la unidad Timbren está correctamente encajado en la copa del tope de retención.
- Para asegurarse de que la unidad Aeon está bien encajada en la copa, es recomendable colocar un separador provisional como un pedazo corto de madera de 2x4 entre el eje y la unidad Aeon antes de bajar el vehículo. Levante el vehículo una vez más para retirar el separador provisional.
- Baje el vehículo.

*No exceda la carga nominal en el eje recomendada por el fabricante del vehículo. Compruebe que no haya interferencia entre el resorte AEON® y los otros componentes del vehículo. Bajo carga, el resorte AEON® se ampliará en diámetro.*

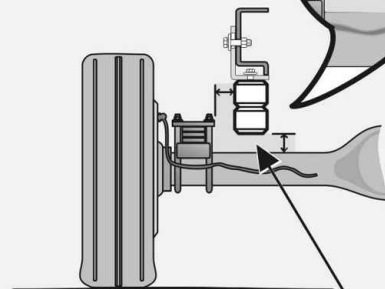

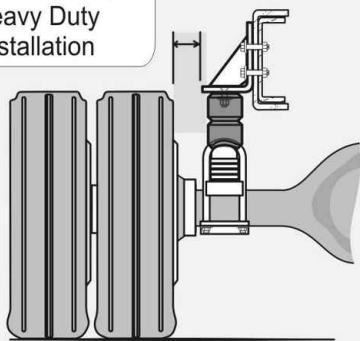

Typical Light Duty Installation

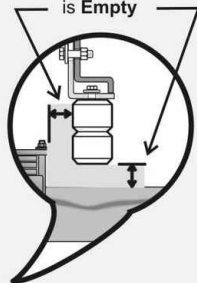


Be sure Rubber spring is seated directly over lower support.

### Clearance Instructions

#### For Light Duty Pickups & Vans

Rear SES kits should have approximately 1" gap between rubber spring and axle for 1/2 and 3/4 tons, and for one ton the gap should be about 1/2" when the vehicle is completely unloaded. A cap or fifth wheel plate will reduce or eliminate this gap.

Front SES kits are usually in contact with the front suspension at all times.

#### For Medium Duty & Heavy Duty Trucks, Trailers, Motor Homes, and more

Medium & Heavy Duty vehicles often have pre-load as outlined in the instruction sheet. (For specific Medium Duty applications with a constant load on the suspension like Rvs, Utility Vans or Cube Vans, the Timbren SES kits are pre-loaded.)

### Consider Your Needs..!

Knowing the use of the vehicle will help you to select the right SES kit. For example a one ton truck can be configured as a pick-up, service vehicle or tow truck. Standard capacity or severe service applications are available for many applications.

Knowing that the suspension has been modified or is old and sagging should indicate the need to adjust the ride height to obtain the correct clearance.

This can be done by altering the SES kit (changing rubber spring or bracket) or re-arching the leaf springs to renew the optimum OEM ride height.
